

## Medical Clinics Blessing Many

Greetings and blessings in the name of our Lord Jesus. As our work continues here in the Dominican Republic we try and help as many as we can that are in need. There has been no shortage of people needing medical care here on the North Coast. The clinic in Paradise village now has over 4000 patients. It has not been an easy ministry to be a part of as it is hard to see so many suffering. It is on the other hand a blessing to be able to help so many that are suffering. When you have someone come to the clinic for the first time and they have blood pressure that is really dangerously high ( ex: 210/100 ) and you give them the treatment they need and they come back next month and their blood pressure has improved and is under control, well that is awesome! When you are able to help those in need you really know what Jesus was saying in Acts 20:35 “ In all things I have shown you that by working hard in this way we must help the weak and remember the words of the Lord Jesus, how he himself said, ‘It is more blessed to give than to receive’”.

Recently we have had a minor outbreak of a new virus spread by mosquitos called Chikengunya. This has made us very busy in the clinics. People come with high fever, body aches and headaches looking for relief. We can give them an IV and some Tylenol and pray for them- then it

just takes time to get better. Our newest crisis is a 9 year old boy who has a tumor on his left calf (pictured bottom right). Please pray for Junior as the doctor in Santiago moves forward with his surgery. (pictured bottom left )

Helping those in need is difficult and rewarding all at the same time! We continue to work with God’s strength and provision. Please remember our patients in your prayers!
