The team attended two church services during their week; A Dominican service and an English service. They were able to do a prayer walk also; this is always a highlight of the week and this year was not different. We got to see two 12 year old girls accept Jesus as their Savior! Many received prayer and were blessed!

Paradise Medical Clinic Update (Covid19)

We are happy to report that since reopening, the clinic continues to work and bless so many on the North Coast of the Dominican Republic. We are working with new safety guidelines in place but our patients are very grateful that we reopened because they were and are suffering a lot due to the Covid19. Many are unable to work because many businesses, hotels, restaurants and such have closed and are still not reopened. We are also having a shortage of supplies available for several reasons. 1) Supplies such as gloves, masks and hand sanitizer are hard to find in Puerto Plata. 2) We count on mission teams to bring us supplies and most teams have canceled for this year. **If you are able to help by sending financial contributions it would be greatly appreciated and needed.** We thank you all for your partnership in this vital important ministry to the Dominican people on the North Coast!
