On March 2 Clearview Community Church mission team from Stayner Canada arrived to work with us **(bottom right)**. Our goals for their week here was to glorify God, help the poor, bless local ministries and pastors and for the team to grow in their faith. The team's construction project was to continue toward the completion of the church in La Vigia. The group worked side by side with local workers and volunteers to pour a sidewalk, smooth coat the outside of the church and tile the floor (**bottom middle**) this meant getting on their knees to lay tile, sifting sand all day, mixing cement on the ground, picking, shoveling and pushing the wheelbarrow and when they took breaks; they always enjoyed playing and talking with the children. At midday we would enjoy the local cuisine under a shade tree which included Dominican rice, chicken and salad with our favorite Tamarindo juice - following lunch we shared in spirit-filled worship led by our amazing translator, Rey **(bottom left).** Ministry during the week included visiting an orphanage and our medical clinics, worshiping, singing and giving testimonies at Church in the Woods and North Coast Community Church, a children's program bringing food, drink and gifts to over 150 children, playing basketball and a very powerful prayer walk led by Pastora Mamota. We want to send a special thank you to Elizabeth Stadtlander for filming us all and doing interviews - she will be making us some new ministry videos; we cannot wait to see them!

The team's last day was spent in Paradise village playing with the children and we went directly from there to the airport. They ministered right up to the very end of their time with us.
