Every year for the last five years we have been blessed to partner with Clearview Community Church mission teams and every year we pray that they would be as big of an encouragement as the last. This year brought another team from Stayner, Ontario Canada (COLD COUNTRY) from March 3 – 10. The team was the largest we have seen from Clearview - 17 people ready for action and they did not disappoint! As they served and worked we were all blessed and encouraged by their unity and love that they had for all of us here. Their work project this year would be to build Pastora Mamota of the village, La Vigia, a house. We started with the foundation digging, pick axing, shoveling and then mixing concrete on the ground as we filled the holes with a wheelbarrow. Some other work that had to be accomplished was cutting rebar with a hacksaw, carrying block, filling in holes with cement as well as sanding and painting the outside of the church. It was great to see the team work right along local workers and volunteers. After two full days of work the team did a program for the children in La Vigia and Chi-chigua. Over 125 children learned about the Good Samaritan through the group's drama that they performed so well. Also, we sang songs together and then each child received a gift, juice and food. Sunday night the team

attended church in La Vigia with Maren Brandsma and James Taylor bringing a shared message of forgiveness that leads to victory. Many people were delivered that night including a few from the team! Praise Jesus! The oil was flowing for anointed healing as well! What a great night of worship and praise to our Savior Jesus Christ, but the story is not finished yet!

It would be wrong not to tell you about the great job our translators Rey and Dennis did! They are an important part of what we do and did a great job!

Partnering With Nexo

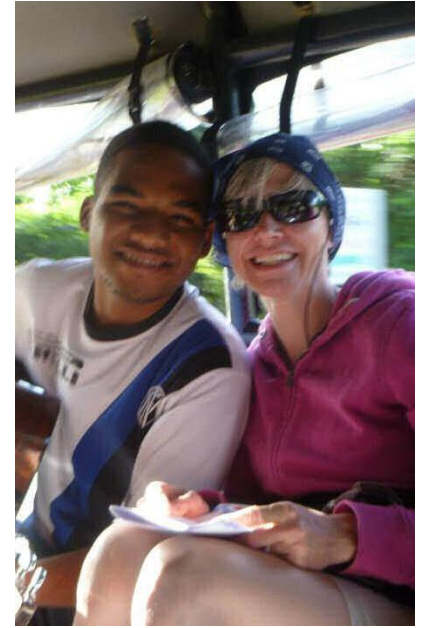
