July 7 - 14 brought us the Heart of Worship mission team from New Smyrna Florida. The theme for the week was "OFF THE HOOK"! This team was made up of people from 5 different churches which was unique and wonderful. After the team made their almost 24 hour journey to arrive here in Sosua, Dominican Republic, they settled into the Rio Vista Mission House. Every day started and ended with devotions and reflection. The first two days were spent in La Vigia mixing concrete and sifting sand in the hot sun to make the floor for a Pastor's house that we are building. They also refurbished and repainted the ceiling of the church in La Vigia. On the second day, 3 people from the team went to the clinic in Paradise village to help Tina. We were blending together and working well as the body of Christ being prepared for the Holy Spirit to use us in our ministry activities that we had scheduled, which leads us to day 3; in the morning we went to Church in the Woods where the team shared some songs and testimonies before hearing a great sermon about how if Jesus was set apart and Jesus lives in us then we are to be set apart also! One team member says she entered the church one person and left a different person- praise Jesus! In the afternoon the team did a children's program in La Vigia and Chichigua blessing and feeding over 150 children. Day 4; the team went to a brand new village for us that we had never been to before. They worked side by side with a local church there to bring 100 families food and to invite them back to the church that night for the Jesus film. As the team delivered food they entered many homes praying for people as there are a lot of needs in this poor community. Many received Jesus as Savior. In the evening we showed the Jesus film and two people from the team shared their

testimonies. Many lives were touched! Day 5; in the morning we went to our English church (Oceanside Christian Fellowship) then after lunch we went to Paradise village to see the clinic and play with the children there. After, we went to the church service in La Vigia where two more testimonies were shared and then the team led worship and preached the Word! The Holy Spirit filled the church and we were all blessed and uplifted as we worshiped together filled with the Holy Spirit! Day 6; we set off for La Vigia as the team wanted to wash the feet of the leaders of Pastora Mamota's church. Powerful! 10 leaders from the church and our 2 translators, Rey and Denis, got their feet washed, were prayed for and received a touch from the Holy Spirit. There were lots of tears and anointing! After lunch we had some worship in the Pastor's newly built living room but not just us, lots of children and some adults heard the music and came to join us. It was "OFF THE HOOK"! After, we went with Pastora Mamota door to door in her community praying for people. This was a week that we can say for certain that many were touched and blessed by the work and service of this wonderful team of volunteers. I know that they would agree when we say that all the credit goes to the Holy Spirit! He touched us all and worked in and through all of us. What a blessing! Lots of tears were shed; lots of cleansing and forgiveness took place including one team member accepting Jesus into her life! I praise my Jesus for handpicking each individual from our group to come together to be "one body" of Christ. I am willing to spend my life serving HIM.
