The last 4 months have been so busy and the word for this time has been “Chikungunya”. This virus has given us the opportunity to help many and show them the love of Christ as we help them. In 4 short months we have received over 500 new patients in the Paradise clinic. People are showing up to the clinic as early as 4:30 am to make sure they get a number as we can only see 50 patients a day. The virus brings people in various conditions, some with fever and pain needing a shot and Tylenol. Others come in worse conditions needing a shot and an IV to rehydrate them as well as vitamins to build immune system strength. We are still attending to all the other patients that have various other ailments.

We have a great staff (**pictured right**) two nurses, a doctor, secretary and a cleaning lady who work hard to care for everyone. We try to help everyone that comes through our doors. We start each day by praying a communal prayer with and for the patients. People feel blessed and tell us that the clinic gives them hope and a better quality of life. As we move forward we are looking at possibly needing to expand in order to meet the needs of our growing surrounding communities. What does this mean? It equates to needing more funds in order to reach more people. **“Remember this: whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows generously will reap generously. Each of you should give in your heart what you have decided to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver. And God is able to bless you abundantly, so that in all things at all times, having all that you need, you will abound in every good work”.**
