Mission Testimonies

This testimony is from Rob Iannone and is about the trip I had June 20 to July 4 2019: For the past 15 years I have been collecting and bringing donations of many things for the poor people in need in the Dominican Republic. In the past 2 years I have been bringing 2 suitcases full of medicine for our Paradise Medical Clinic every time I travel there. This medicine has been generously donated by a good friend and partner in our ministry, Juan Lopez who is a Pharmacist. This year when I arrived to the Puerto Plata Airport I was stopped by Customs and they took one of my suitcases full of medicines that the patients in our medical clinic needed greatly. The next two days were spent trying to get the suitcase out of Customs but I was not able to. It was a very stressful situation and it made me lean on God even more. I could not worry or deal with this anymore because I had the team from Crosspointe Church arriving for a week and so I worked with them all week and really just forgot about the suitcase and medicines sitting in Customs. God really blessed our time and that week on our prayer walk we had 6 people accept Jesus as Savior including one elderly woman who had rejected salvation many times on previous visits! The day the team left one volunteer stayed with me, Jerry Perez and we went to a village to visit our friends. On this visit we went for a walk and talked with a young couple about Jesus and they received Jesus as Savior also! I had one more day before I had to leave and I got a call from our friend Dr. Lambert who was helping me to get the bag of medicine out of Customs, He told me to go to meet with the people at Public Health at 9am. I spent the whole day there but was able to get the letter needed to get our medicine! Praise the Lord! I was reminded to lean more on God and trust and have faith!
