When we first met Addy he had a limp and a swollen right thigh. Then he got worse and we starting helping him and his mother get the testing for a diagnosis. He had a biopsy and the doctors were saying it was likely cancer. Immediately we sent out the message to all our prayer partners to start praying because we believe strongly in the power of prayer! Their travels brought them to a cancer hospital in Santo Domingo where they immediately wanted to do another biopsy. Prayers were answered as the biopsy came back....NO CANCER! The new diagnosis was a bone infection called Osteomyelitis, still serious but not cancer, praise God! Addy has endured a great deal of pain and suffering but after several surgeries the report is looking good as his bone is healing. We are testifying once again to all of you that read this....**Prayer works!** Please continue praying for Addy and for his mother Santa. They both have been through hard times but we have always witnessed them smiling through the whole thing.
